


Innovation & technology: Made in Switzerland

Switzerland, and especially the Greater Zurich Area are recognized worldwide as leaders in the areas of research and knowledge.

The long-established exchange between academic institutions and industry make the location very attractive for research-intensive companies. The Greater Zurich Area's capacity for innovation is secured in the long term by the presence of renowned globally connected universities such as the University of Zurich, the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH Zurich), the Swiss Federal Institute of Aquatic Science (Eawag), and the Swiss Federal Laboratories for Materials Science and Technology (Empa), as well as internationally leading R&D labs in the private sector, e.g. Disney Research, Google, and IBM.



Greater Zurich Area: A culture of innovation

From labs to markets

The Greater Zurich Area is the economic engine of Switzerland and one of the most dynamic business locations in Europe. The highly qualified and productive talent pool, top-tier research institutions, and a business-friendly regulatory framework create a unique drive for progress and innovation.

This deeply ingrained culture of innovation is what truly sets the Greater Zurich Area apart. Switzerland tops the charts in patents per capita, according to the 2022 Patent Index by EPO, and is among the leading nations in R&D investment relative to GDP. This drive for innovation is especially prominent in the Greater Zurich Area, evidenced by its thriving startup and venture capital scene. Of the over CHF 2 billion Swiss startups received in 2024, more than CHF 970 million were invested in the Greater Zurich region, as indicated by the Swiss Venture Capital Report 2025.

Diverse funding possibilities

When comparing venture capital investment per capita, Switzerland ranks among the top countries worldwide. Further, public funding can be granted by institutions such as Innosuisse, which has an annual budget of approx. CHF 200 million. In addition, state-level cantonal authorities have various instruments to support companies with direct subsidies or incentives. These measures vary between the individual states and are decided on a case-by-case basis.

Driven by the innovative spirit and funding possibilities, the Greater Zurich Area boasts a unique network of pioneering companies and leading research institutions, supported by state-of-the-art infrastructure, providing major business advantages for their enterprise.

Variety of industries

The Greater Zurich Area is the business hub of Switzerland – not solely due to its culture of innovation, business-friendly environment, and political stability. The economic region enclosing the financial metropolis of Zurich employs around 1.5 million multilingual and international staff from industries such as robotics & intelligent systems, life sciences, fintech & blockchain, foodtech and advanced manufacturing.
